**ABSTRACT:** After 2 single spaces from author address, a short abstract of the paper and it must be labeled as the abstract with the word "Abstract". The Abstract should not more than 250 Words. Please do not use any abbreviation and compound numbers in the abstract.

**From here there must be single spaces before the next heading.**

**KEYWORDS:** The Abstract must be followed by five to eight keywords.

**INTRODUCTION:**

- Manuscripts should be written in a clear and accurate fashion with careful attention to detail.
- Mention the full form of abbreviations when they appear for the first time in the text.
- All Figures, Tables, and Schemes should be inserted into the appropriate points of the text.

- Structural, Formulae, Figures, Illustrations and Graphs must be original line drawings or sharp glossy photographs. Schemes and Figures must be drawn with help of ChemDraw or other similar software.
- All nomenclature should be simple, unambiguous, and in conformity with the conventions developed by the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry.
- References should be denoted in Small Roman numerals and provide a list of references at the end of the paper. Arrange your list in the order in which the references appear in your text. Use superscript Small Roman numeral to show when a statement in your text has an external reference source, for example Witting<sup>iii</sup>. Usually these should appear at the end of the sentence (after the punctuation), but can be after the relevant word or compound.

Number all references in Small Roman numerals and each reference should be typed single spaced. The hanging indent (0.35) for each reference makes the sequence more obvious.

Arrange your list in the order in which the references appear in your text.

Use superscript Small Roman numeral to show when a statement in your text has an external reference source, for example Witting<sup>iii</sup>. Usually these should appear at the end of the sentence (after the punctuation), but can be after the relevant word or compound.

If a statement has multiple references you should reference all of the citations in the text. If you have two citations, or if you have more than two and the numbers are not consecutive, use commas (with no spaces) between roman numerals, for example x,xi or v, x,xii. If there are more than two numbers and they are consecutive, use an en-dash to separate the first and last citation, for example x–xx

References must be typed in the following order: Surname and initials; followed by title of the article; name of journal in abbreviated form; (name of book in normal); publication year, **volume no.** and page no.

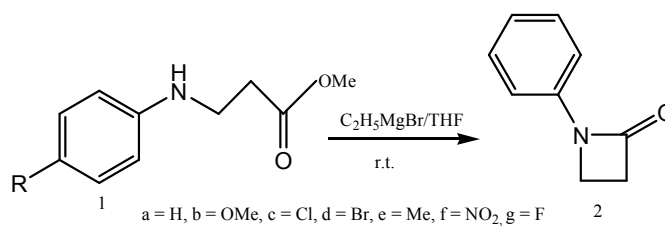
